

Year 9 ICT ILT

During Year 9 students have been working on completing Unit 21 for their Key Stage 4 coursework. This represents 33% of their final grade.

Students have the opportunity to improve their Unit 21 work in Year 10 and Year 11.

All students however must have this work completed to at least a Pass (equivalent to a C grade) standard before the end of term.

To help students who have yet to finish this work, a letter will be sent to all parents of pupils who have not yet finished, to make them aware their son/daughter needs to attend a catch-up session after school on Thursday 8th July and Thursday 15th July from 3:30 – 5:00 in computer room B1. ICT teachers will support students during this time with completing any missing sections of work.

The Unit consists of 6 Assessment Objectives revolving around creating 3 website graphics for a specific company of the pupil's choosing. All 6 need to be completed.

Unit 21 – Web graphics

AO1 – Analysis of at least 2 web graphics

AO2 – Designs for 3 different web graphics, 1 Banner, 1 Navigation Bar and a set of 3 Roll over buttons

AO3 – Navigation Bar created

AO4 - 3 Roll-Over Buttons created

AO5 – Banner created

AO6 – PowerPoint presentation to the client showing the web graphics that have been created, persuading them why they suit their target company and how they might be used.
